The Making of Memphis

Live From Memphis Rock 'N' Roll Pianos and More started with the vision of Neil Morrow, who booked his first paying gig at 14 years old and hasn't stopped playing music since.

The Anaheim native has performed around the world and shared the stage with the likes of the Beach Boys, John Stamos, Jerry Lee Lewis and Tom Jones – all of whom he remains friends with today. Though Morrow has played a range of music in his 24-year career, the sounds of one city have consistently inspired everything from his preferred playlists to his signature pompadour.

"I've always been infatuated with the music and history that came out of Memphis, Tennessee," said Morrow. "I am very influenced by artists like Elvis Presley, Johnny Cash and Jerry Lee Lewis, who came out of Memphis on the Sun Records label."

In summer 2013, Morrow decided the time was finally right to open a club of his own. With the dedicated team from Haymor Investments and some experienced partners by his side, Morrow began searching for the right location. Then the right location found him, after the folks at Dos Lagos caught wind of what he was planning.

"Dos Lagos saw something unique that would capture interest and draw people," Morrow said. "They think outside the box, which is why we are a perfect fit for each other."

Backed by a friendly staff and a handpicked team of entertainers, Morrow succeeded in bringing Memphis to the Inland Empire. Catch him there most nights, leading his band in a honky-tonk jam session or commanding laughs during one of his outrageous dueling piano shows. Say hello, give him a song request – just don't touch his hair.

Q: Are you opening a bar in Memphis?

A: No – at least not yet! We're bringing the sights and sounds of Memphis, Tennessee to Corona, California.

Q: Is it a restaurant, a piano bar or a concert venue?

A: Yes! We open for lunch at 11 a.m. and serve food until just before close every night, with a full menu of Memphis-themed dishes designed just for us by our talented chef. While the food alone will make Memphis worth the trip, our focus is on providing high-quality entertainment. We'll offer Open-Mic Mondays, rockabilly and roots rock 'n' roll on Tuesdays and Honky-Tonk Sundays, plus a can't-be-missed dueling piano show every Wednesday through Saturday.

Q: What exactly is a dueling piano show?

A: We take a stand-up comedian who can play piano and sing just about every hit song you can recall. We sit him at a piano opposite another player, equally talented and ready to improvise. Then we give you control of the show, with a chance to make song requests, get your friends roasted on stage or simply sing along.

Q: Will I need a reservation?

A: They're not required, but they're strongly recommended. We're big enough to accommodate large parties and a lively crowd, but intimate enough to make you feel at home – that is, as long as you get in!
